35b 36	Any Other Breed than a Shire Young Handler. For the best Young Handler over 12 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show. To be judged on their <i>Showing and Handling Ability</i> and not the Animal. These animals need not have been entered in any other class. No entire stock to be shown in this class. A Tankard to be awarded to the winner, at the Grand Parade.
